INSTRUCTIONS: Simply count butterflies/moths for a 15-minute period during bright (preferably sunny) weather. Count the maximum number of each species that you can see at a single time. For example, if you see three Red Admirals together on a buddleia bush then record it as 3, but if you only see one at a time then record it as 1 (even if you saw one on several occasions) – this is so that you don't count the same butterfly/moth more than once.
