probably apple-core introduction

olive family; v common in our region

on the concrete

grassland edge near point

334 microspp currently recognized in British Isles!

alien very rampant cultivar; grassland edge

lovely dangling flowers; "barren" = no agric'l use

common waste ground Chinese alien

abundant near point

crushed leaves smell of fresh celery

by flyover; alien (80+ nat'l'd spp, 1 native, in Britain)

grassland edge

possibly native

thought Nat Scarce pre '90s; flourishes round Bristol

alien, spread along railways in 19th century

232 microspp currently recognized in British Isles!

grassland edge near point

common seashore dock

just under flyover; leaves smell deliciously of apples

grassland edge

grassland edge

just by start of grassland; scrambling climber; native

probable conker introduction

the common ivy sp in SW - supports Ivy Broomrape

classed Nat Scarce pre '90s; can grow up to 2.5m!
