Looking ahead – a chance for conversation

1. In response to Ed Hall's article for Bristol 24/7, four new subscribers have joined the list. Ed Hall agreed to correspond with a local journalist, Kate White who would like to follow up on the story.
2. Ed also happy to be the initial contact for Sarah Hobbs, a researcher from Bath University on water spaces – a project called RESPiRES (www.respires.org) looking at the health and resilience of waterbodies, working in Bristol and Mexico City as case studies. Possible contact for future speaker.
3. FrANC members may borrow up to 2 litter pickers, tabards and hoops on long term loan if, individually or in a pair, they are keen to get out to collect rubbish. Ed's contact details to be sent via mailchimp. The long litter-pickers, if borrowed, would need to be returned the same day.
